



NICOTINE USE GUIDELINES

The use of vape products as an alternative to tobacco use at Black Bear Lodge will follow the same guidelines and expectations as tobacco use:

Patient Vaping/Tobacco Use Guidelines, including dip/chew:

- Patients are not permitted to vape or use tobacco while walking the campus or while waiting for appointments. Tobacco use and vaping are only permitted by patients in the following areas:
 - Designated sheltered hut outside of the Ballroom, side of parking lot at Theater (Men only)
 - Sheltered hut across the parking lot at Theater (Women only)

- Only approved vapes are accepted and must meet the following criteria:
 - Vapes can only contain nicotine. No THC or CBD vapes will be approved.
 - Vapes must be unopened and factory sealed, and non-tampered.
 - Vapes must be disposable and discarded once empty, such as Vuse. No refillable vapes, or vape juice, are allowed.
 - Staff must look over and approve vapes at admission or once brought to campus before they will be given to the patient.
 - Unapproved vapes, including those not meeting the criteria or appearing to have been tampered/alterred, will be discarded.

- Patients are not permitted to vape or use tobacco while walking the campus or while waiting for appointments. Tobacco use and vaping is only permitted by patients in the following areas:
 - Designated sheltered hut outside of the Ballroom, side of parking lot at Theater (Men only)
 - Designated sheltered hut across the parking lot at Theater (Women only)
 - The back porch of the cabin or room they are assigned to – “guest” patients can not use tobacco/vapes on the back porch, and should not be inside, of rooms/cabins they do not stay in (men and women)
